Skilled Rehabilitation Unit

Comprehensive multidisciplinary skilled rehabilitation for patients who are ready to be discharged from the hospital but not ready to return home or begin rehab. Diagnoses include, but are not limited to:

- Orthopedic fracture
- Joint replacements
- Stroke patients
- Deconditioning
